McMAHON ASSOCIATES, INC. WINS ALICO CONNECTOR ROAD PROJECT

Fort Myers, FL - McMahon Associates, Inc., a full-service transportation engineering and planning firm with over 30 years of service, was selected by the Lee County Department of Transportation to provide transportation engineering services for the Alico connector road study.

The proposed roadway will connect Alico Road to SR-82 and will provide a new route for traffic from the eastern edges of the county to access I-75 and the rest of Lee County. It will also complete the final piece of the CR-951 corridor and provide for a new north-south roadway that extends from Marco Island north to the Caloosahatchee River.

As the prime consultant on the project, McMahon is conducting a corridor alignment study for the new roadway and leads a team of engineering, environmental, archaeological, survey, and public involvement professionals. The study will review several possible alignments for feasibility and cost and provide a final recommended corridor. With approval from the Board of County Commissioners, Alico Road will then move into the final phases of right-of-way, design, and construction. The project is expected to begin October or November 2006 and will take approximately twelve to eighteen months for completion.
